- Mississippi Legislature (State Funds)
 - General Funds Appropriation (\$76M)
 - Education Enhancement Funds Appropriation (\$4.4M)
- U.S. Department of Education (Federal Funds)
 - Carl Perkins Grant (\$13.6M)

What Reports are Used to Track CTE Salary Reimbursements?

• VETB-100 (CTE Teacher Budget Report)

- Shows individual CTE Personnel reimbursements and the <u>total CTE</u> <u>funds</u> the district will receive for the current school year.
- The CTE Director enters data and monitors this report regularly, ensures all pending issues are resolved, and provides a copy of the report to Business Managers, monthly or quarterly basis is recommended.

VEFE-110 (CTE Monthly Expenditure Report)

- Report provides Business Managers with a <u>monthly</u> salary reimbursement breakdown of funds received via EFT.
- The Business Manager should compare the Teacher Budget report to the Monthly Expenditure Report for accuracy/<u>changes in personnel</u>.

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CTE End-of-Year Reconciliations

- CTE Directors must make final revisions to the teacher budget by the <u>end of May.</u> They should check to make sure teachers listed on the report are licensed and teaching that CTE program with the correct percentage of time.
- CTE Directors will provide an updated copy of the Teacher Budget report to Business Officers by the <u>end of May</u>.
- Business Officers should compare the teacher budget report with the monthly expenditure report to determine the remaining funds due to the district from CTE.
- MDE will make <u>final end-of-year payments during the months of June and July</u> based on CTE Directors' adjustments in May.
- Business Officers should contact MDE, if there are any discrepancies between the total amount of CTE funds reimbursed by the end of June and the amount shown on teacher budget report provided by the CTE Director at the end of May.

NOTE: With budget uncertainties, any reconciled funds must be reimbursed to districts or returned to MDE on or before July 31st of each year. Business Officers must ensure that all CTE funds have been received before filing year-end financial statements in Financial Electronic Transfer System (FETS) (FETS).
